4. Business Arising from the December 12, 2019, AGM Minutes -

Bullet point #8 - Motion to determine the PRMS municipal shareholder members' desire to introduce term limits for PRMS Board of Directors. The recommendation was to be obtained in 2020 through Board & CAO meetings and brought forward to the November 20, 2020 AGM however this was not achieved due in part to the restrictions imposed by Covid 19 which led to the postponement of CAO meetings.

5. Budget Review – 2021 Budget and 2021-2023 Requisition – Devin Diano

PRMS CEO, Devin Diano explained the current state of PRMS finances and provided the background information considered in the preparation of the 2021 Budget and the 2021-2023 Requisition which was accepted by the PRMS Board of Directors at the September 18th, 2020 board meeting. Chairman George Glazier called for questions and there being none, he requested a motion to accept the 2021 Budget for ratification by the full membership.

It was determined that the discussion for ratification of the requisitions be reserved for annual review by the Board of Directors and presented for ratification at the AGM.
